The University Museum's classical collections are among the largest, most diverse, and systematically collected of any museum in the U.S., with particularly important Etruscan material spanning the entire history of the Etruscan peoples from the 9th to the 2nd centuries B.C. The strengths of the Roman collection are the glass, coins, sculpture, and the excavated objects from the Italian sites of Colonia Minturnae and the Sanctuary of Diana at Nemi.

The *Guide* illuminates ancient societies by explaining and contextualizing the ways objects were created and used. Brief essays touch on everyday life, language, commerce and trade, religion, and death and burial among the Etruscans and Romans.
