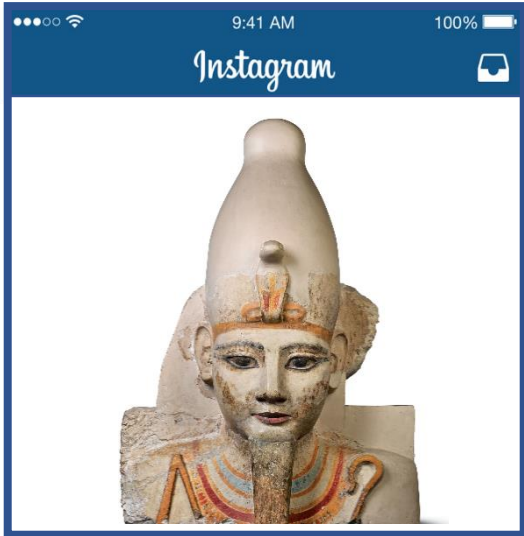

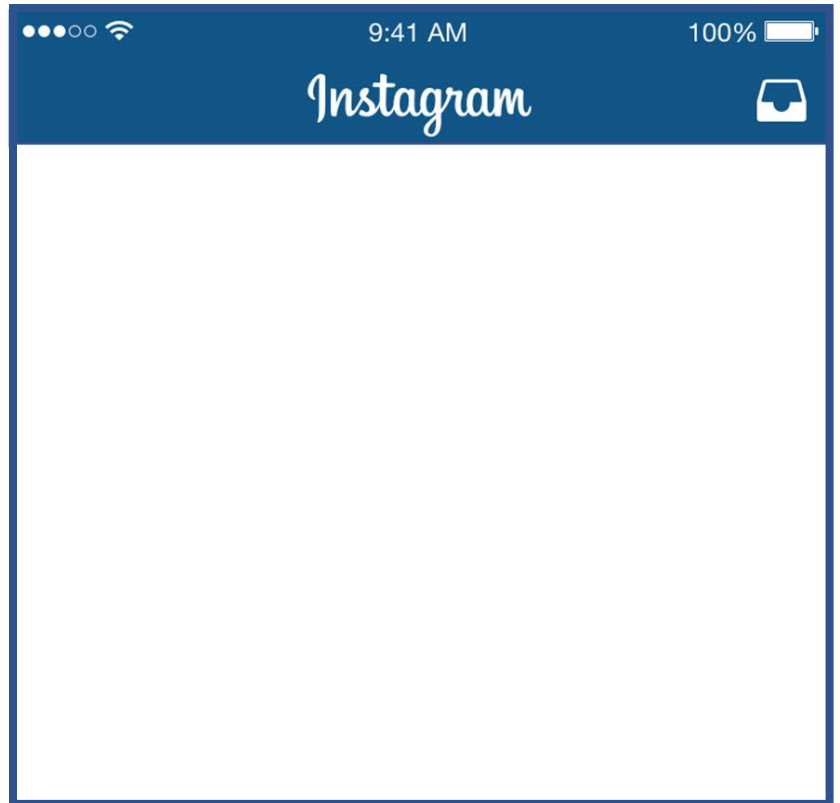

Head of a Colossal Statue of Ramesses II
Limestone (Restored)
Excavated at Abydos
1290–1224 BCE (Reign of Ramesses II, Dynasty 19)

Depicting the upper part of a colossal figure of Ramesses II, this is one of several that once stood in the courtyard of a small temple at Abydos. The king appears as a mummy, in the style of the god Osiris, and holds the symbols of kingship, the crook and flail. Since the figure was intended to tower over any human below, the eyes look down.
